"Body Builders"

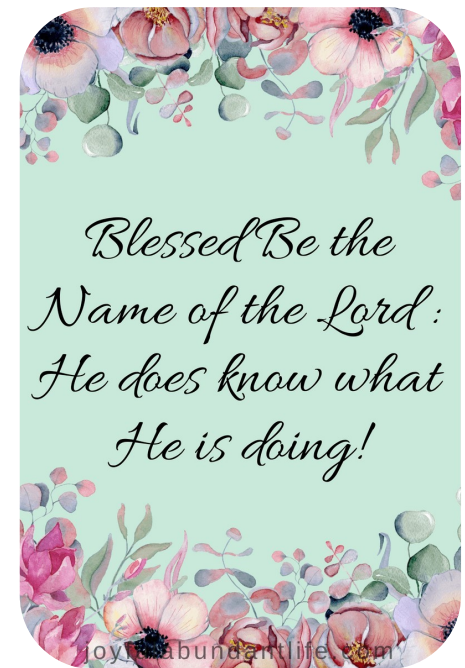
Looking for young adults who would like to build up their bodies in Christ as we explore the book of Ephesians.
