Join us for a mission trip to Lee County, VA this coming July 27-31, 2022. The cost is about \$75 total for lodging, about \$25 for meals and cost of transportation on your own to the worksite. The folks in Lee County are open to practically anything we would like to do as a team. The following possibilities are available but by no means exhaustive...servant evangelism, home repairs, bathroom repair, replacing floors, building handicap ramps, mowing and cleaning yards, power washing structures, VBS/BYBC, block party, and senior adult ministry. The community is poor and in need of folks like us who are willing to offer a few days of love, service, prayer and worship.

Join us for a mission trip to Soldotna, Alaska this coming June 26—July 2, 2022. The cost is only airfare to/from Alaska...probably about \$800 to \$1000. If the group chooses, there could be some cost with any free time events like whale watching, fishing, sight-seeing, etc. on a free day. Work includes assisting with construction and renovation projects at a Christian camp. Tasks may include remodeling, new construction, framing, welding, electrical, painting, plumbing, roofing, drywall, tree removal, trail maintenance, vehicle maintenance, and so much more. We need folks with skills AND folks who are simply willing to help. Camp will provide building materials for the project. Unless the team wants personalized tools, all equipment will be provided. Team can stay at the camp. Showers, meals and beds are provided by the camp for all volunteers.
