Our Poland mission team will leave this evening at 6:30pm. The team will fly first to Munich, Germany for a brief layover and then on to Warsaw, Poland. They will travel three hours by car northeast of Warsaw to Ilawa, Poland where they will spend Tuesday through Sunday working with Ukrainian refugees and children who have fled the war and Russian invasion. They will cook, serve meals, clean-up, handle laundry and generally provide food and housing support for the refugees. The team will also offer encouragement, prayer and the gospel message about Jesus' love, death and resurrection. Poland is six hours ahead of our time in Kannapolis. So, at 6:00am or 6:00pm, we invite you to take a moment and pray for our members serving in Poland, the refugees, the work of NC Baptist Men and NC Baptist Disaster Relief and for an end to the war in Ukraine. Pray for God to be glorified through the work of our team and for them to serve safely while in Poland. Pray for all travel arrangements to function smoothly and safely. The team will return to the United States on Monday, May 9, landing in Charlotte around 4:30pm. The team members are Lee Forrest, Jimmy Wyatt, Sherry Wyatt, Frank Hyatt, Patti Miller and Tom Cabaniss.


