SESSION 18 FREEDOM, FRUIT, AND GENTLENESS

"For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery. " (Galatians 5:1)

I. FREEDOM

- A. The leadership of the Lord is what keeps us free
 - 1. We stay free by obeying Him
 - 2. This is how we endure, persevere, and have hope
- B. Even though we are free to do anything, not everything is good for us
- C. Paul encourages the Corinthians to flee from sexual immorality, reminding them that they were bought with a high price (1 Corinthians 6:12, 18-20)
- D. You are a slave to whatever controls you (2 Peter 2:19, Psalm 27:4)
 - 1. The human heart obeys that which it desires
 - 2. You will not endure if you are desiring things that will kill you
- E. Live in your liberty as a bondservant to Christ (1 Peter 2:15-17)
- F. Bound by freedom (Romans 6:18)
- G. Do the will of God from the heart (Ephesians 6:6)
- H. Crucified with Christ, we are free, but choose to repent and turn from our sin1. Crucify envy, ego, entitlement, bitterness
- I. The Parable the Seeds (Luke 8)
- J. Each one is tempted when drawn away by his own desires; God does not tempt us (James 1)

II. FRUIT

- A. The Fruit of the Spirit are what enable us to steward the Gifts of the Spirit in an edifying way (Galatians 5:22)
- B. Many of us would say that we want to remain free, but struggle to do so
 - 1. We are given guidelines for how to respond when a member of the family of Christ falls (Galatians 6:1-5)
- C. Each one is responsible for himself, but we are all in this race together
