I. THREE PURPOSES

- A. THE STORYLINE
 - 1. Jesus' second coming is the main event of the New Testament, and the rapture is not a separate subject; it is part of the most climactic moment of the greatest story ever told
- B. THE NATURE OF THE RAPTURE
 - 1. To bring clarity and truth in light of false, toxic, and destructive teachings
- C. THE URGENCY
 - 1. Approaching a time of rapid acceleration in terms of End Times events
 - 2. The first time in 2,000 years that prerequisite events are either fulfilled or being fulfilled

II. THREE VANTAGE POINTS

- A. THE BIBLE
 - 1. No evidence of a pre-tribulation rapture in the Bible
- B. CHURCH HISTORY
 - 1. No early church fathers ever mention a pre-tribulation teaching
- C. THE PERSECUTED CHURCH
 - 1. Evacuation vs. endurance

- A. To be anchored
- B. To anchor others
- C. To warn others

- A. There are good people who
 - 1. Believe in the pre-tribulation rapture
 - 2. Disregard truth
 - 3. Are unaware that a debate exists.
