

## JESUS, LORD OF YOUR LIFE PART I

### I. THE MESSAGE OF PREMINENCE

- A. We must bring into perspective the Lord of all the universe having a relationship with with a single being, with the individual
- B. Jesus, through His death, has provided the means by which we can find right-relationship with God ([Colossians 1:21-23](#))
- C. The message of preeminence doesn't exclude us, it includes us
- D. If we live, we live for the Lord; if we die, we die for the Lord ([Romans 14:8-9](#))
  - 1. Jesus as Lord of both the dead and the living

### II. JESUS IS LORD

- A. Unless Jesus is the Lord of all things, He isn't Lord at all
- B. Every knee will bow and every tongue will confess ([Philippians 2:9-11](#))
  - 1. This passage has both present and future implications
- C. We do not make Jesus Lord, He IS Lord
  - 1. We need only surrender
- D. The central message of the Bible is that Jesus is Lord
  - 1. As believers, we must reconcile what we will do in response to that
- E. There is no other stream; we must go through His Lordship
