How often would I have gathered your children together as a hen gathers her brood under her wings, and you would not! 38 See, your house is left to you <u>desolate</u>. 39 For I tell you, you will not see me again, until you say, 'Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.'" (Matthew 23:37-39)
