# Eph. 3:1-6

### **SERMON SUMMARY:**

In Ephesians, we find Paul writing his letter from a Roman prison. Yet, he believes his present circumstances were worth it given the importance of his mission: to share the gospel with the Gentiles. In our passage today, we will learn why Paul was motivated to evangelize. Then we will focus on practical steps to encourage joining Christ in his mission.

### **SERMON OUTLINE:**

## **Paul's Motivation**

God was sovereign over Paul's circumstances.

Paul took responsibility for the lost Gentiles.

## The Mystery is Revealed

Salvation is open to all people.

## A Call to Evangelize

Embrace <u>Paul's motivations</u> to <u>fuel</u> your <u>heart</u> for the lost.

Reject intolerance, colonialism, and white religion narratives.

Not everyone is <u>gifted</u>, but all are <u>called</u> to evangelize.

Do not make sharing the gospel complicated.

- Talk through both of Paul's motivations for evangelism. Why are each important to remember?
- Why does Paul refer to the inclusion of the Gentiles as the mystery of the Gospel?
- What keeps us from evangelizing?
