LIVE WITH SPIRITUAL ARMOR

Ephesians 6:10-24

SERMON SUMMARY:

We now conclude Paul's letter to the Ephesian church by tackling one last aspect of the Christian life: the spiritual war. Paul lays out the reality of the spiritual forces at work, and then how to respond to it. By putting on the armor of God, we will stand firm.

SERMON OUTLINE:

The Source of Evil There is real evil in the world, and this evil comes from the great enemy of God: <u>The Devil.</u>

The Strength of the Lord Our ability to <u>fight</u> in the <u>spiritual battle</u> comes when we are joined with <u>Christ</u>.

The Need for Armor We often underestimate our crafty enemy.

Put on The Armor of God

The armor enables you to <u>stand firm</u>... "So that" you may <u>boldly proclaim</u> the <u>gospel</u>.

Application

Be <u>alert to</u> and recognize the <u>allure</u> of the schemes of the Devil. <u>Continually</u> be joined with Christ as you live for Him.

- What kinds of schemes is the devil up to? How can we be watchful?
- Why do we fall for the Devil's schemes sometimes? What makes his tactics attractive?
- What steps can we take to continually stay joined with Christ?
