LIVE IN GODLY MARRIAGE

Ephesians 5:22-33

SERMON SUMMARY:

When we view the statistics between married Christians and married non-Christians, we see a disturbing trend. This leads many Christ-followers to despair. Can my marriage get better? But that isn't the whole story. Today, we will pay attention to the key ingredients to a Godly and flourishing marriage.

SERMON OUTLINE:

The Myth

Marriage between Christians is <u>no better off</u> than marriage between non-Christians.

The Truth

When we function within how God designed marriage, we flourish.

God's Design for Marriage

Submission is not a <u>role</u>, it is a <u>response</u>. The wife's role is <u>helper</u>, and the husband's role is <u>servant leader</u>. Marriage points to <u>Jesus</u>.

Application

<u>Beware</u> of your great <u>Enemy</u>. Connection to <u>each other</u> is facilitated by connection to <u>God</u>.

- In what ways does the Enemy seek to destroy our marriages? What tactics does he use?
- Talk about the triangle analogy vs the tick analogy. What happens when you function in each?
