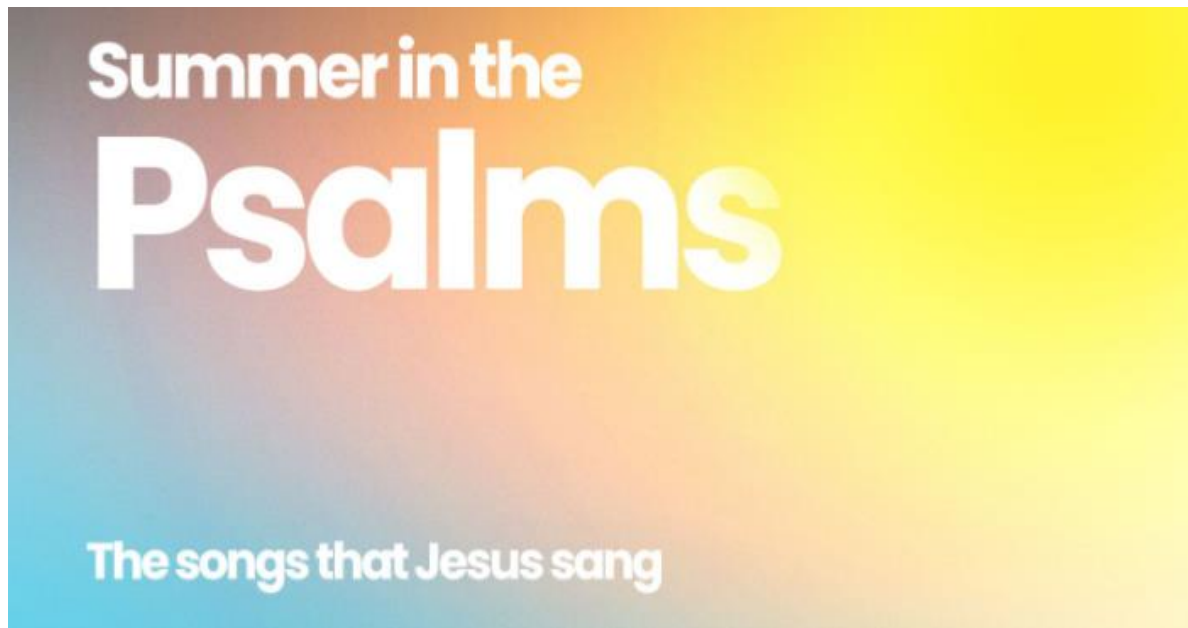




**“It’s so good to be here” – Psalm 122**

3. Why is Unity in the Church important and how can it be achieved? What role do you as an individual play in this?
4. How can we have Peace - both as a church and individually? What are things that threaten it and how can they be overcome? Consider the Connection Bob made between Jerusalem (Place of Peace) and Jesus’ suffering and death.
5. How might you become a peacemaker in this world?
