Irresistible Grace— Luke 5:27-39

Jesus encounters Levi, the tax collector, whom many would have written off as 'beyond redemption'. In this glorious salvation story, Jesus 'sees' with eyes of grace and love, a God-image bearer so broken and ruined by sin and chooses him to be in the bride of Christ!
