



The Call to Be Different - Titus 3:1-8

In this stand-alone message, Pete Greasley encourages us to respond to a broken world with grace and humility and to fix our eyes on our ultimate hope - our eternal inheritance with Christ.

For personal reflection/ community discussion:

- **What struck you as you listened to this message?**
- **What is your experience of social media?** Do you see the hating the Pete described?
- **Break down the gospel chain described in verse 4 - 7.** Spend time understanding each link. Don't rush past these, but pause and rejoice in each one, thanking God specifically for every clause.
- **Consider verses 1 - 3. Where are you most conscious of the change that's taken place in you by the Holy Spirit?** Where do you still need his grace to reshape you? In light of this message, what do you need to bring before the Lord in honest confession and repentance?
- **"He saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy" (vv.5-7).** Where are you tempted to base your identity on what you do,

achieve, or prove? What does it look like practically to live from the confidence that you are saved by God's mercy?

- **Paul calls believers to be people who are ready to do good and show gentleness to everyone (vv.1–2).** Who is the person or group of people you find hardest to approach with kindness and humility? What would it look like to reflect the generosity of Jesus toward them?
