General Flynn Endorses Jan 6er Derrick Evans for US House in West Virginia¹

- General Michael Flynn just endorsed a January 6th defendant for the U.S. house in west Virginia.
- The gateway pundit reports general Flynn has endorsed former member of the west VA house of delegates, Derrick Evans who is reportedly a supporter of president trump and the America first movement.
- Evans posted this on social media, "I'm running for congress to take on the deep state.
- Most politicians talk about, I already did it. I'm the only elected legislator in the country to be arrested for peacefully protesting on Jan 6th. From WV state rep to us congress, I will never give up & I'll never back down."

US Carries Out Air Strikes in Syria Against Iran-Linked Facilities ²

- The U.S. carried out strikes against Syria and Iran linked facilities over the weekend.
- Per *Newsrael*, it was President Biden who ordered the strikes. U.S. defense secretary Lloyd Austin stated, "The president has no higher priority that the safety of U.S. personnel, and he directed today's action to make clear that the U.S. will defend itself, its personnel, and it's interests."
- This strike is the third one since October 26th as the U.S. attempts to stop rocket and drone attacks against American troops which took place on soldiers stationed in Syria and Iraq, following the beginning of the Israel-Hamas war.

Iran's Growing Influence in Latin America Threatens Jews in the Region³

- Iran has been a growing concern and influence in Latin America as they threaten Jews in those regions.
- CBN news reports Brazil recently foiled a terror attack last week that targeted Jewish people after Israel's Mossad tipped off authorities about the plot. Two members of Hezbollah were reportedly arrested in connection to the terrorist plot.
- Dr. Evan Ellis, a Latin American specialist at the U.S. army war college is warning that Iran's growing influence in those regions is a direct threat to the U.S. as well as the Jewish community.
- The Dr. believes that if the U.S./Iran conflict escalates that Iran will mobilize Hezbollah and other groups throughout the hemisphere.

<u>Iran's Growing Influence in Latin America Threatens Jews in the Region</u>³

- Iran also reportedly influenced Chile, Bolivia, Honduras, and Colombia to recall their ambassadors from Israel after Hamas attacked. The Bolivian government actually announced that they will cut diplomatic ties with Israel.
- If you recall, earlier this year, socialist Brazilian government officials ignored U.S. protests and allowed Iran to dock two warships in Rio de Janeiro as Iran's influence grows in that area.

Rashida Tlaib Breaks Down in Tears on House Floor as She Attempts to Make Herself the Victim ⁴

- Rashida Tlaib has officially been censured by the House for her antisemitic and anti-American rhetoric regarding Israel.
- The western journal reports the Michigan representative is Palestinian-American and has used her platform to spread hate and lies about the war between Israel and Palestine.
- One example was publicly blaming Israel for the bombing of a hospital and refusing to apologize—after evidence proved the rocket actually belonged to Hamas terrorists.
- She also posted a video on "x" formerly twitter with the antisemitic chant "from the river to the sea" which ends with Palestine must be free—which implies the end of Israel as a sovereign nation and by extension the Jewish people.
- The vote to censor her on the house floor passed with 234 voting in favor of her being censured with 22 democrats jumping on board, and 188 including republicans who opposed.

KEY PASSAGES

• Psalm 83:1-18

(Prayer to Frustrate Conspiracy Against Israel)

- Bible "Misfits" | Hall of faith (Hebrews 11)
 - Abraham
 - vv. 8–10, ⁸ By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place which he would receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going. ⁹ By faith he dwelt in the land of promise as *in* a foreign country, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise; ¹⁰ for he waited for the city which has foundations, whose builder and maker *is* God.
 - vv. 17–19, ¹⁷ By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac, and he who had received the promises offered up his only begotten *son*, ¹⁸ of whom it was said, "In Isaac your seed shall be called," ¹⁹ concluding that God was able to raise him up, even from the dead, from which he also received him in a figurative sense.

- Bible "Misfits" | Hall of faith (Hebrews 11)
 - Sarah
 - vv. 11–12, ¹¹ By faith Sarah herself also received strength to conceive seed, and she bore a child when she was past the age, because she judged Him faithful who had promised. ¹² Therefore from one man, and him as good as dead, were born *as many* as the stars of the sky in multitude—innumerable as the sand which is by the seashore.
 - Isaac
 - v. 20, ²⁰ By faith Isaac blessed Jacob and Esau concerning things to come.
 - Jacob
 - v. 21, ²¹ By faith Jacob, when he was dying, blessed each of the sons of Joseph, and worshiped, *leaning* on the top of his staff.
 - Joseph
 - v. 22, ²² By faith Joseph, when he was dying, made mention of the departure of the children of Israel, and gave instructions concerning his bones.

- Bible "Misfits" | Hall of faith (Hebrews 11)
 - Moses
 - vv. 23–28, ²³ By faith Moses, when he was born, was hidden three months by his parents, because they saw *he was* a beautiful child; and they were not afraid of the king's command. ²⁴ By faith Moses, when he became of age, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, ²⁵ choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin, ²⁶ esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt; for he looked to the reward. ²⁷ By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king; for he endured as seeing Him who is invisible. ²⁸ By faith he kept the Passover and the sprinkling of blood, lest he who destroyed the firstborn should touch them.

- Bible "Misfits" | Hall of faith (Hebrews 11)
 - Israelites
 - vv. 29–30a, ²⁹ By faith they passed through the Red Sea as by dry *land, whereas* the Egyptians, attempting *to do* so, were drowned. ³⁰ By faith the walls of Jericho fell down after they were encircled for seven days.
 - Rahab
 - v. 31, 31 By faith the harlot Rahab did not perish with those who did not believe, when she had received the spies with peace.

- Bible "Misfits" | Hall of faith (Hebrews 11)
 - o Gideon, Barak, Samson, Jephthah, David, Samuel, and the prophets...
 - vv. 32-40, ³² And what more shall I say? For the time would fail me to tell of Gideon and Barak and Samson and Jephthah, also of David and Samuel and the prophets: 33 who through faith subdued kingdoms, worked righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions, ³⁴ quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, became valiant in battle, turned to flight the armies of the aliens. 35 Women received their dead raised to life again. Others were tortured, not accepting deliverance, that they might obtain a better resurrection. ³⁶ Still others had trials of mockings and scourgings, yes, and of chains and imprisonment. ³⁷ They were stoned, they were sawn in two, were tempted, were slain with the sword. They wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins, being destitute, afflicted, tormented—³⁸ of whom the world was not worthy. They wandered in deserts and mountains, in dens and caves of the earth. ³⁹ And all these, having obtained a good testimony through faith, did not receive the promise, ⁴⁰ God having provided something better for us, that they should not be made perfect apart from us.

KEY PASSAGES

• **Hebrews 12:1–2,** Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares *us*, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, ² looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of *our* faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
