Paul's Sermon:

4. He turns from telling them general truth to telling them what they're supposed to do about it. (Acts 17:30-31)
5. Some mocked, and some believed. (Acts 17:32-34)

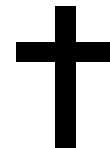
5 Patterns of Approach:
