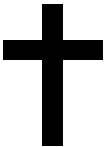

Discussion Questions

Centered on the Gospel Part 5: Living in Grace and Truth

1. What most stood out to you from Sunday's message? Is there any part you hope we discuss together?
2. John 1:17 says Jesus is "full of grace and truth." What do you think that means? What does it mean that He was completely full of both grace and truth?
3. Pastor Josh went over several stories of Jesus' interactions with people, like the woman at the well in John 4, the calling of Matthew the tax collector in Matthew 9, and the thief on the cross in Luke 23. Looking at those stories and others, what did it look like for Jesus to be both fully gracious and confidently speaking the truth to people?
4. What about the current social climate makes it difficult to speak truth to people in a way that it will be received well? How do you struggle with that personally?
5. If you could grow in your interactions with people when it comes to being both radically gracious and bold with the truth to be more like Jesus, how would you like to grow? How can we encourage each other in this?
