Discussion Questions

Centered on the Gospel Part 8 Heart Change

1. What did you learn or take away from the Sunday message? Which part do you hope we discuss together?
2. What difficulties have you had in trying to grow spiritually? What methods have you tried that haven't given you the results you hoped for?
3. Read Luke 6:43-45. The heart is the center of your life - what you actually hope in, trust in, cling to, and worship, not what you wish your heart was, but what it actually is. How have you seen your heart driving your actions, whether good or bad?
4. Read Matthew 22:36-40. Jesus emphasizes that the core motivation for obeying all of God's commands should be to love God and love people. How different would your life look if you fully loved God and people? Be specific.
5. Read Romans 8:1-4; 1 John 4:18-19. How is it that the love of Christ in the cross can change our motivation, our love, our heart? What about Christ's love changes you?
6. What would it look like in your daily life to spend time abiding in Christ and receiving His love for you?

Communion: We take Communion every Sunday as a church body. At his last supper with his disciples, Jesus "took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to them, saying, 'This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me.'" (Luke 22:19). Anyone who believes in Jesus Christ as their personal savior is welcome to grab a cup from the tables at the front or back of the auditorium and eat it on your own during the following song. There is juice on the top and a cracker underneath. You do not have to be a member here to join us.
