Discussion Questions

Gentle and Lowly

Read Matthew 11:28-30.

1. Jesus says that He is "gentle and lowly in heart." What do you think He means? How does Jesus' description of Himself counter our conceptions of Him?
2. Jesus extends His invitation for rest in Him to "all who labor and are heavy laden." What does it mean to feel that way, not just physically, but down deep? How have you felt that way?
3. Pastor Josh shared an illustration from Ortlund's book about a doctor who isn't frustrated when people accept his help, but happy, because that's what He's there for. How does thinking about Jesus like this help us in how we approach Him?
4. Jesus invites us to come to Him and learn from Him. When we look at how Jesus lived, how would you describe the way He lived from day to day? How did He prioritize His time?
5. If Jesus were in your exact life situation, how do you think He would live?
6. What is one concrete step you can take in coming to Jesus, finding rest in Him, and learning a new way of life by being with Him and modeling your life after His?
