Discussion Questions

Made For Mission 1 Peter 1:1-9

- 1. How would you describe the Mission of Christ's church and how does that involve your small group?
- 2. What are some things in your life that you feel are/could be crowding out holiness as a top priority?
- 3. How does the truth of God's foreknowledge bring you relief about being on God's mission?
- 4. Why is receiving God's mercy sometimes difficult for you?
- 5. How would you further engage with God's mission if you were absolutely certain that your faith could never fail?
- 6. What is one thing you want to remember, change, or view differently in light of our discussion today? How can this group support you?

Communion: We take Communion every Sunday as a church body. At his last supper with his disciples, Jesus "took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to them, saying, 'This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me." (Luke 22:19). Repeating this act is a powerful image of our ongoing covenant renewal with the once crucified and now resurrected Christ. Anyone who believe in Jesus Christ as their personal savior are welcome to grab a cup from the tables at the front or back of the auditorium and eat it on your own during the following song. There is juice on the top and a cracker underneath.
