Sermon Notes

Gender & Sexuality Part 5: A Theology of Desire

- I. God's vision for sexuality & marriage helps us spot the counterfeits. (Gen. 2:24)
- II. How can love be wrong?
 - A. Love is not at war with law. (Rom. 3:19-20)
 - B. It's not that God's law no longer applies. It's that God's law no longer saves.
 - C. Everyone puts limits on when love is no longer good. The difference is simply where we place those limits, and Christians place those limits where God's law places those limits.
- III. What if God made me this way? (Rom. 7:14-20)
 - A. Through the Fall, we all have broken desires.
 - B. We all have desires that A) we didn't ask for and B) we would gladly get rid of if we could (e.g. addictions).
 - C. Sanctification doesn't exempt us from temptation.
- IV. No one is irredeemable.
 - A. You are not alone in your struggle. (1 Cor. 10:13)
 - B. No one needs the blood of Jesus more than anyone else. (Rom. 3:20-24)
- V. The Gospel brings freedom. (Rom. 8:1-4)
 - A. There is no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.
 - B. The righteous requirement of the law is fulfilled in those who trust in Jesus, because Christ fulfilled the law on our behalf.
 - C. We are now empowered not to walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.
