Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: What does this scripture passage say?

Reflection and Discussion: What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures? Talk together about how the scriptures connect to everyday life.

Look up and read Colossians 1:15-18 and Acts 13:1-5

- 1. What do these verses tell us about Christ's relationship with the Church?
- 2. What are the characteristics of a strong Christ-led Church?

Look up and read 1 Peter 2:9 and Ephesians 4:11-12

- 3. What do these verses tell us about the role of church members in the life of the Church?
- 4. Describe "healthy ministry".

Look up and read Acts 14:23, 1 Peter 5:1-4, and Hebrews 13:17

- 5. What do these verses tell us about the ministry of elders in the Church?
- 6. What is the role of a shepherd?

Look up and read Ecclesiastes 4:12

7. Describe the benefits of shared leadership. Why is this important?

Surrender: Responding to God's voice.
