Small Group Discussion Questions

Getting Started

Pacing Your Group

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: *What does this scripture passage say?*

Take some time to look up and read: Matthew 1:18-23, Isaiah 9:1-7, Luke 2:8-11, John 1:12-13

1. How can Joseph and Mary’s messy “family situation” be an encouragement to us?
 2. How does Old Testament prophecy point specifically to the birth and life of Jesus?

Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures?*

Talk together about how the scriptures connect to everyday life.

3. What is your favorite Christmas movie? What do you like about it? How can you connect this movie to the story of Christ?
 4. What aspects of faith and hope are the most important to remember in this season? What is the opportunity in Christmas for a Christian?
 5. Christmas is a time of remembering. Share a Christmas tradition or memory that means something significant to you.
 6. How can the story of the birth of Jesus help us to share the gospel? Give a short gospel presentation to your group and include the birth of Jesus in your sharing.
