Small Group Discussion Questions

Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion.
Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through “observation” leaving enough time for “reflection”, “discussion”, and “surrender.”

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: *What does this scripture passage say?*

Take some time to look up and read:

Exodus 12:1-17, Matthew 26: 17-28, 1 Corinthians 10:16, 1 Corinthians 11:23-29,

1. What do these verses tell us about communion?

Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures?*

Talk together about how the scriptures connect to everyday life.

2. What are the differences and similarities between the Passover Meal celebrated in the Old Testament and Communion?
3. Celebrating Communion positions us to “remember Christ” and to “proclaim Christ”. What is the benefit of the regular practice of “remembering” and “proclaiming” as followers of Christ?
4. What experiences and perspectives on Communion have you found encouraging or challenging in your church experience and walk with Christ?

Surrender: Responding to God’s voice.

5. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
