Getting Started

Observation: What does this scripture passage say?

Take some time to look up and read: 2 Timothy 2:14-26

- 1. Summarize the main cautions, warnings, and principles about conflict and engagement given in these verses.
- 2. How does Paul describe an individual that is ready and prepared for God's work?

<u>Reflection and Discussion:</u> What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures? How do the scriptures connect to everyday life.

- 3. What troubles is the Church facing in this text? Are these troubles similar or different when compared to the Church today?
- 4. How are Christians hurting the reputation of Jesus, the church, and Christianity as a whole? What do you think of the phrase, "Christians are nothing like Christ"?
- 5. What tactics do those opposed to Christianity use when challenging our faith and beliefs?
- 6. What does it mean for Christians to win hearts, not arguments? Why is this important?
- 7. When have you engaged with an unbeliever/opponent in an undeniably positive way, perhaps experiencing "the gentle art" of winning a heart for Christ?
- 8. Identify some of the interactions of Jesus and how he demonstrated the "the gentle art" of winning hearts.

Surrender: Responding to God's voice.
