Small Group Discussion Questions

## **Getting Started**

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion. Expect God to move through your time together!

#### **Pacing Your Group**

Move quickly through "observation" leaving enough time for "reflection", "discussion", and "surrender."

### **Scripture Reading**

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: What does this scripture passage say?

## Take some time to look up and read Revelation 2:8-11

- 1. How is Christ portrayed/described in this passage? (v8)
- 2. What encouragement does Christ have for the suffering? (v9-11)

# Reflection and Discussion: What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures? Talk together about how the scriptures connect to everyday life.

- 3. The church in Smyrna struggled against two hostile forces: a Jewish population strongly opposed to Christianity, and a non-Jewish population that was loyal to Rome and supported emperor worship. Persecution and suffering were inevitable in an environment like this.
- What "environmental factors" may cause persecution and suffering for the church in our nation?
- In what ways is the Gospel a threat to the kingdoms of the world?
- 4. Pain is part of life, but it is never easy to suffer, no matter what the cause. Jesus commended the church at Smyrna for its faith in suffering. Share a story about faith in suffering.
- 5. Imagine for a moment that Christianity is now illegal and punishable by slow and painful death. What part of your life would not have to change to meet the law?

#### Surrender: Responding to God's voice.

- 6. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
