Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion. Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through “observation” leaving enough time for “reflection”, “discussion”, and “surrender.”

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation, Reflection, and Discussion:

1. Take turns reading the “I am” statements of Jesus.
 - **I AM the Bread of Life:** John 6:35
 - **I AM the Light of the World:** John 8:12
 - **I AM the Door:** John 10:9
 - **I AM the Good Shepherd:** John 10:11
 - **I AM the Resurrection and the Life:** John 11:25-26
 - **I AM the Way, the Truth, and the Life:** John 14:6
 - **I AM the Vine:** John 15:5
2. What does it look like to fully accept these “I AM” statements in your daily life?
3. What “I AM” statements might be most helpful in communicating the Gospel message?
4. In John 10:30-33, Jesus claims “oneness” and equality with the Father. How can this help us to understand the nature, character, and motivations of God?

Surrender: Responding to God’s voice.

5. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
