Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion. Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through "observation" leaving enough time for "reflection", "discussion", and "surrender."

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: What does this scripture passage say? Take some time to look up and read: John 11:1-44

- 1. What threat does Jesus face in returning to Bethany?
- 2. How does Thomas respond to Jesus?
- 3. How does Martha react upon Jesus' arrival? How does Mary react?

Reflection and Discussion: What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures? Talk together about how the scriptures connect to everyday life.

- 4. How would you define a "crisis of faith"? When does it happen? Why?
- 5. What are your greatest resources when facing a "crisis of faith"? What prevents or delays your access to them?
- 6. How are Mary and Martha's experiences and understandings about Jesus challenged in this passage? What new paradigms are they learning?
- 7. What questions about your current life situation do you need to face honestly before God? Where do you need a miracle?
- 8. What has been your biggest breakthrough over this Experiencing God sermon series? Tell that story.

Surrender: Responding to God's voice.

- 9. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
 - ** Take some time to pray for one another in response to what has been discussed today **
