Small Group Discussion Questions

Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion. Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through “observation” leaving enough time for “reflection”, “discussion”, and “surrender.”

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: *What does this scripture passage say?*

Reflection: *What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures?*

Discussion: *Talk together about how the scriptures connect to everyday life.*

In Christ, we are loved by God relentlessly

Read Romans 8:1-4 and Romans 8:31-39

1. How do these verses describe the relentless love of God?

In Christ, the deepest stains of our sin are permanently removed

Read Ephesians 1:3-7 and Hebrews 9:11-14

2. What do these verses explain about the mysterious and amazing process of salvation?

In Christ, we are empowered by the Holy Spirit

Read Galatians 2:20 and Galatians 5:16-18

3. What is the result of being empowered by the Holy Spirit?
4. Which aspect of your salvation do you tend to think about the most? Why? Tell that story.
 - Love
 - Forgiveness
 - Empowerment
5. Our experience during this COVID-19 pandemic seems to change weekly. Who are you most concerned for right now? After each person shares, pray as a group.

Surrender: Responding to God’s voice.

6. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
