Small Group Discussion Questions

Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion. Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through "observation" leaving enough time for "reflection", "discussion", and "surrender."

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: *What does this scripture passage say?*

Take some time to look up and read: Acts 2:41-47

1. What do these verses tell us about community?

Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures?*

Talk together about how the scriptures connect to everyday life.

2. The new followers of Christ in the book of Acts were united with other believers, taught by the apostles, and included in the prayer meetings and fellowship.
 - How has community influenced your early years as a follower of Christ?
 - How is community influencing you today?
3. As part of God's spiritual family, it is our responsibility to help one another in every way possible. God's family works best when its members work together.
 - Describe a time when you or someone you know was blessed and helped by community.
 - Describe a time when God used your gifts, talents, or abilities to bless others.
4. Healthy Christian community attracts people to Christ. How can we make the church the kind of place that will attract others to Christ?

Surrender: Responding to God's voice.
