Observation, Reflection, and Discussion:

** Principle 1: If we want to be used by God, anytime, anywhere, we must know His will.

Read: 2 Peter 3:9, Matthew 23:37, Revelation 7:9-10

- 1. What do these scriptures teach us about God's will?
- ** Principle 2: If we want to be used by God anytime, anywhere, we must know His calling on our lives Read: Genesis 12:1-3, Jeremiah 1:4-5, Hebrews 9:14, 1 Peter 2:9
 - 2. What do these scriptures teach us about God's calling on our lives?
- ** Principle 3: In order for God to work through us anytime, anywhere, we must adjust our lives and join God in His work

Read: John 5:19-20, Luke 19:1-9

3. What do these scriptures teach us about adjusting our lives to join God in His work?

Surrender: Responding to God's voice.
