### **Getting Started**

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

## Observation: What does this scripture passage say?

#### Take some time to look up and read Revelation 2:12-17

- 1. How is Christ portrayed/described in this passage?
- 2. How is the church in Pergamum portrayed/described in this passage?
- 3. What prescription or "action step" is given to this church?

# Reflection and Discussion: What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures? Talk together about how the scriptures connect to everyday life.

- 4. Pergamum was called the city "where Stan has his throne." Surrounded by worship of Satan and the Roman emperor as god, the church at Pergamum refused to renounce their faith, even when someone was martyred. What pressures and temptations of society threaten Christian faith?
- 5. There is room for differences of opinion among Christians in some areas, but there is no room for heresy and moral impurity. There is tension between bowing to pressure and being open-minded. What values, actions, or boundaries are helpful when discussing, debating, and thinking through differences of opinion among Christians, our brothers and sisters in Christ?
- 6. It is not completely clear what "hidden manna" is referring to in this passage, but it suggests spiritual nourishment that satisfies. Describe spiritual nourishment. Are your nourished?
