Small Group Discussion Questions

Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion.
Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through “observation” leaving enough time for “reflection”, “discussion”, and “surrender.”

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: *What does this scripture passage say?*

Take some time to look up and read Acts 16:1-15

1. Describe some of the milestone moments of Paul’s missions work.
2. What unique turn of events occur in verses 6-10?
3. What fruitfulness did Paul experience because of this turn of events?

Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures?*

Talk together about how the scriptures connect to everyday life.

4. What stands out to you from this message? What is getting your attention?
5. What complexity or “closed doors” did you experience in your life and/or ministry in 2020?
6. Has it been easy or difficult for you to, “Go To Troas” and look to God for re-direction? Tell your group about it.
7. As you think about the conference theme “ReModel: All Things New,” what aspects of your life are at the beginning, middle, or end of God’s remodeling?

Surrender: Responding to God’s voice.

8. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
