Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion. Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through "observation" leaving enough time for "reflection", "discussion", and "surrender."

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: What does this scripture passage say?

Take some time to look up and read: 2 Timothy 3:16, Hebrews 1:1, 1 Thessalonians 2:13, Matthew 24:35

1. What does the Bible say about the Bible, about itself, in these verses?

<u>Reflection and Discussion:</u> What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures? How do the scriptures connect to everyday life.

- 2. What is the Bible to you? What is the function of the Bible? How is the Bible different from every other book and work of literature?
- 3. What are some reasons for neglecting the Bible, even though as Christians we recognize its significance and importance?
- 4. What both the Bible and history weave together in seamless harmony, as though the creator ordained this plan and recorded it in Scripture... the unity of Scripture demonstrates its Supernatural inspiration. - Consistency: Thousands of cross-references
- Preservation: It's survival and authentication over thousands of years
