Small Group Discussion Questions

Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion.
Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through “observation” leaving enough time for “reflection”, “discussion”, and “surrender.”

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: *What does this scripture passage say?*

Read: Psalm 32

1. According to this psalm, what do we receive when we are forgiven?
2. According to David, what does it feel like to keep our sin in secret? (v3,4)

Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures?*

Talk together about how the scriptures connect to everyday life.

3. There is no greater blessing than to be fully forgiven. There is no greater curse than the heartache of “secret” sin. If we confess our sin, full forgiveness is just a whisper away. As we admit our need, we are “hidden” in the grace of God. What makes confession and forgiveness so difficult for many Christians to grasp and experience?
4. To be proud, independent, or stubborn is foolish and leads to much sorrow. What areas of your life are hard to surrender to Christ and feel like a struggle?
5. God’s steadfast love surrounds those who trust Him, bringing great gladness and joy. Share a recent story about surrender and trusting God that resulted in gladness and joy.

Surrender: Responding to God’s voice.

6. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
