### **Getting Started**

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion. Expect God to move through your time together!

## **Pacing Your Group**

Move quickly through "observation" leaving enough time for "reflection", "discussion", and "surrender."

## **Scripture Reading**

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

#### **Observation:** What does this scripture passage say?

#### Read: Acts 418:24-28

- 1. What words would you use to describe Apollos? (v24-25)
- 2. What response do Aquila and Priscilla have in response to hearing his teaching? (v26)
- 3. Where does Apollos go after his time with Aquila and Priscilla? What happens? (v27-28)

# Reflection and Discussion: What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures? Talk together about how the scriptures connect to everyday life.

- 4. The preaching and teaching of Apollos was accurate but incomplete. God uses Priscilla and Aquila to explain the Gospel more completely, helping to prepare Apollos to defend the faith in Western Greece. How has God used community and relationships to help you learn new or deeper aspects of the Christian faith? Who comes to mind as someone who has helped you? What did he/she teach you?
- 5. Aquila and Priscilla are used by God to equip Apollos for the work that God had prepared for him in Achaia. What experiences, wisdom, and breakthroughs has God blessed you with that may be helpful in equipping others? Have you ever been prompted by God to speak truth, encouragement, or correction into the life of another follower of Christ? How did it go?
- 6. Take some time to think about your current walk with God through the experience of Apollos and Priscilla/Aquila in Acts 18. Are your answers "Yes" or "No" to the following questions? What stands out after thinking about your answers to these questions?
