Small Group Discussion Questions

Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion. Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through “observation” leaving enough time for “reflection”, “discussion”, and “surrender.”

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: *What does this scripture passage say?*

Take some time to look up and read: Matthew 25:14-46

1. How did each of the three servants approach the stewardship of resources entrusted to them? (v14-28)
2. What were the consequences/results for each servant? (v14-28)
3. What is the fate for obedient followers vs. pretenders and unbelievers according to verses 31-46?

Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures?*

Talk together about how the scriptures connect to everyday life

4. When have you experienced the “joy of giving” or the “joy of receiving” – sharing or receiving from the Godly stewardship of others?
5. What resources (time, abilities, gifts, connections, materials, assets, money, PFDs, etc.) has God given you to steward?
6. How much of those resources would God have you give generously?
7. Where would he have you give them?

Surrender: Responding to God’s voice.

8. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
