Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: What does this scripture passage say?

Luke 22:31-34

1. What sobering response does Jesus give to Peter's confident declaration?

Luke 22:54-60

2. What words does Peter say in each of his three denials?

Luke 22: 59-62

3. What does Peter do after the rooster crows?

Reflection: What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures?

- 4. How do modern day followers of Christ "deny" him?
- 5. What are some of the reasons that a follower of Christ would "deny" their faith?

Discussion: Talking together about how the scriptures connect to everyday life.

- 6. If you had the power to completely eradicate one of the modern ways that Christians "deny" Jesus, which one would you choose? Why do you think this particular "denial" means so much to you?
- 7. From this humiliating experience, Peter learned much that would help him later when he assumed leadership of the young church. Share a time in your life when God used a humiliating experience or a personal failure to prepare you for something significant.

Surrender: Responding to God's voice.
