Small Group Discussion Questions

Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion. Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through “observation” leaving enough time for “reflection”, “discussion”, and “surrender.”

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: *What does this scripture passage say?*

Philippians 3:4-6, Acts 26:9-11, Acts 9:1-2

1. Who was Saul? Describe him.

Acts 9:3-9

2. How did Jesus pursue and invade Saul's life?

Acts 9:10-22

3. What did God provide for Paul after his radical conversion?

Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures? Talk together about how the scriptures connect to everyday life.*

4. Describe your life before relationship with Christ. What parts are difficult/painful to remember and talk about? Why?
5. How has Jesus pursued and invaded your life? What has He transformed and “made new”?
6. How has God provided help for you along the way through your transformation and sanctification?

Surrender: Responding to God's voice.
