

# How To Hear God's Voice

## **Getting Started**

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion. Expect God to move through your time together!

### **Pacing Your Group**

Move quickly through "observation" leaving enough time for "reflection", "discussion", and "surrender."

### **Scripture Reading**

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: What does this scripture passage say? Take some time to look up and read: Genesis 1:1-3

In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. <sup>2</sup> The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters <sup>3</sup> And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light.

Reflection and Discussion: What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures? Talk together about how the scriptures connect to everyday life.

1. God speaks through the creation (Psalm 19:1-4

- What in your life displays the beauty of God?
- How can you better observe His voice through creation?
- 2. God speaks through Scripture (Hebrews 4:12)
- What has God been saying to you through His Word? How have you been responding
- If you haven't been hearing God speak to you through His Word, why do you think that is? What might you need to do to change that?

- 3. God speaks through circumstances (Proverbs 3:5-6, John 5:19, James 1:2-5)
- Are you in the midst of a confusing situation? How are you seeking God's perspective on it?
- Is God speaking to you through a circumstance in your life? What is He saying: How is that being confirmed by God's word, your times of prayer, and other believers?
- 4. By His Spirit (John 16:12-15)
- In what ways does Spirit guide you (how)?
- What does it mean that He will guide you into all truth?
- Share a story where the Spirit guided you into truth . . .

### Surrender: Responding to God's voice.

5. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
