Observation: What does this scripture passage say?

Take some time to look up and read: 1 Corinthians 3:5-9, 1 Peter 2:9-12, 1 Corinthians 9:19-23

1. What do these verses tell us about our role in introducing Jesus to others?

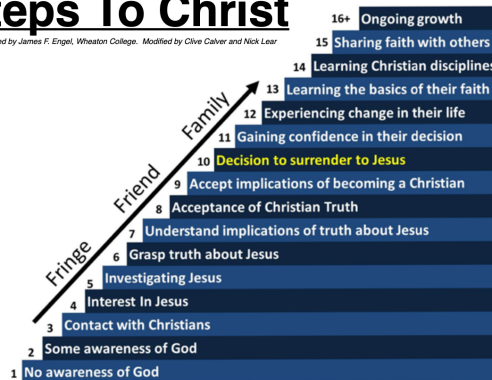
Reflection and Discussion: What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures?

How do the scriptures connect to everyday life.

2. Name the people God used to lead you to Christ. What role did they play? At what number was their influence in your life according to the “Steps to Christ” chart?

5. What are the obstacles to merging your Christian “universe” with the other “universes”/communities you are a part of? Where are the “open doors”?
6. Who are you inviting to Easter?

Surrender: Responding to God’s voice.
