#### Getting Started

#### Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

#### Observation: What does this scripture passage say?

Take some time to look up and read Acts 2:37-47, Ephesians 1:15-23, Matthew 5:14-16

- 1. Describe the fellowship of the believers in Acts Chapter 2? (Acts 2:37-47)
- 2. What image is used in Ephesians 1 to describe the unity of the church? (Ephesians 1:15-23)
- 3. What image is used in Matthew 5 to describe the mission of the church? (Matthew 5:14-16)

# Reflection and Discussion: What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures? Talk together about how the scriptures connect to everyday life.

- 4. If someone completely new to Christianity were to ask, "What is the church, anyway, and why does it matter?" how would you answer?
- 5. Describe a time when your experience of church felt completely in line with God's intended design for the Body of Christ.
- 6. Why is diversity (gifts, abilities, perspectives, etc.) important in a church community?
- 7. What hope or encouragement can the church offer and reflect to our community?
- 8. What is your biggest hope for the future of the church?

#### Surrender: Responding to God's voice.

- 9. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
