Small Group Discussion Questions

Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion.
Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through “observation” leaving enough time for “reflection”, “discussion”, and “surrender.”

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: *What does this scripture passage say?*

Take some time to look up and read: 1 John 4:7-10, 1 Corinthians 13:1-3, Romans 5:8

1. How is love foundational to our relationship with God and others?

Take some time to look up and read: 1 John 1:14, John 6:28

2. What did Jesus leave to complete his mission on earth?

Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures?*

Talk together about how the scriptures connect to everyday life.

3. Love explains so many things:
 - Why God creates: because he loves, he creates people to love
 - Why God cares: because he loves them, he cares for sinful people
 - Why we are free to choose: God wants a loving response from us
 - Why Christ died: His love for us caused Him to seek a solution to the problem of sin
 - Why we receive eternal life: God’s love expresses itself to us forever

How can these explanations of God’s love inform how we share the gospel and engage others?

4. What things are challenging to “leave behind” when engaging people with God’s love and the gospel? Think beyond physical location.
 5. Read John 8:6b-11, Hebrews 2:9. In these verses Jesus “lowers” Himself both physically and spiritually. Why is our posture and our attitude so important when it comes to engaging others for Christ?
 6. How do we partner with the Holy Spirit when we have spiritual conversations, bringing encouragement and challenge?
