Small Group Discussion Questions

Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion. Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through “observation” leaving enough time for “reflection”, “discussion”, and “surrender.”

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: *What does this scripture passage say?*

Read: Colossians 3:1-17

1. According to this passage, what do we receive when we are “re-born” in Christ?
2. Describe some of the differences between the “old-self” and the “new-self”.

Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures?*

Talk together about how the scriptures connect to everyday life.

3. As followers of Christ, we are called to put to death “old self” ways of thinking, talking, and indulgence.
 - On your journey with Christ, where have you been successful and victorious in killing “old self”?
 - On your journey with Christ, where are you currently in a battle to put something to death?
4. Paul offers a strategy to help us live for God day by day:
 - Imitate Christ’s compassionate, forgiving attitude (v12, 13)
 - Let the peace of Christ rule in your heart (v15)
 - Keep God’s Word in you at all times (v16)
 - Let love guide your life (v14)
 - Always be thankful (v15)
 - Live as Jesus Christ’s representative (v17)
- Which strategy do you see in a member of your group. Tell them about it.
- Which strategy do believe God is helping you to experience in your life?
- Which strategy do you want more of?

Surrender: Responding to God’s voice.

5. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
