Small Group Discussion Questions

Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion.
Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through “observation” leaving enough time for “reflection”, “discussion”, and “surrender.”

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: *What does this scripture passage say?*

Take some time to look up and read: 2 Corinthians 5:17-21

1. What do these verses tell us about being “In Christ”?
2. What does the phrase “God making his appeal through us” mean?

Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures?*

How do the scriptures connect to everyday life.

3. Here is a short list of verses and Biblical truths that capture “life in Christ”:
 - Apart from God you can do nothing (John 15:5)
 - Apart from God you have no good thing (Psalm 16:2)
 - God finishes the work he begins (Philippians 1:6)
 - God came so that we can have an abundant and full life (John 10:10)
 - God has a plan for loneliness (Psalm 68:6)
 - God can renew our minds (Romans 12:1-2)
 - God desires to make his name famous in your life (Psalm 23:3)

Continue the list... what truths and verses would you add to this list that amplifies life in Christ?

4. Whose story of life change was influential in your coming to Christ or growing in Christ?
5. What part of your life change story do you believe to be the most powerful in helping others see God?

Surrender: *Responding to God's voice.*

6. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
