- 1. Summarize Paul's conversion and personal encounter with Jesus Christ (Acts 9).
- 2. Besides Paul's conversion, summarize the other miracles of Acts 9.
- 3. What was Peter's vision (Acts 10)?
- 4. How did Peter's vision speak to the Jew-Gentile conflict?

# <u>Reflection and Discussion:</u> What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures? How do the scriptures connect to everyday life.
