Getting Started

Pacing Your Group

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: What does this scripture passage say?

Take some time to look up and read John 3:22, Mark 3:14-15

1. What do these verses tell us about the ministry of Jesus on earth?

Take some time to look up and read Ephesians 5:15-17

2. What encouragements and challenges are found in these verses?

Reflection and Discussion: What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures? Talk together about how the scriptures connect to everyday life.

- 3. What stands out to you from this message? What is getting your attention?
- 4. What is "discipleship"? Have you been "discipled"? Tell about the experience.
- 5. How did Jesus' relationship with the 12 disciples change between his first calling them and Jesus' ascension into heaven? What happened in the space in-between?
- 6. Who do you believe God may be calling you to disciple? What next steps could you take in that relationship to move toward discipleship?

Surrender: Responding to God's voice.
