Small Group Discussion Questions

Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion. Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through “observation” leaving enough time for “reflection”, “discussion”, and “surrender.”

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: *What does this scripture passage say?*

Take some time to look up and read Luke 1:5-25

1. What message did the angel Gabriel bring to Zechariah?
2. How did Zechariah respond and what were the consequences of his response?

Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures?*

Talk together about how the scriptures connect to everyday life.

3. Has God ever asked you to participate in supernatural/impossible things? Tell that story.
4. Where do the promises of God come into conflict with your “possible”? In other words, identify a place, person, or circumstance where it’s really difficult to trust God’s promises to be true? What would supernatural breakthrough look like?
5. If you were to give your life a “spiritual evaluation,” what would you confidently say God is doing right now? General and specific.
6. What action steps can you take to embrace what God is doing?

Surrender: Responding to God’s voice.

7. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
