Then, spitting on the man's eyes, He laid His hands on him and asked, 'Can you see anything now?' 24 The man looked around. 'Yes,' he said, 'I see people, but I can't see them very clearly. They look like trees walking around.' <sup>25</sup> Then Jesus placed His hands on the man's eyes again, and his eyes were opened. His sight was completely restored, and he could see everything clearly."
