Pt. 3 Repenting of Our Sins

Matthew 5:4

 \Rightarrow "Mourning" is used in the Bible in 2 of different ways.

1st ... It refers to mourning over the <u>loss</u> of a <u>loved one</u>.

2nd... It refers to mourning over the <u>loss</u> of our <u>spiritual integrity</u> in relationship to God.

<u>Statement #1</u>... It is feeling <u>sorry</u> for our sins against God to the point that we <u>grieve</u> over them deep down within our <u>innermost</u> being.

<u>Statement #2</u>...Mourning is an intense spiritual <u>experience</u> where I lay my <u>faults</u> before God understanding that my sin is spiritual <u>decay</u>, <u>disease</u>, and <u>death</u>.

Statement #3..."Mourning" allows us to recognize our own sinfulness and equips us to change - this is called "repentance" throughout the Bible.

- \Rightarrow **3 Positive Changes...** take place when we mourn over our sins against God.
- 1. Mourning Demonstrates Personal <u>Responsibility</u>
 - 1) I <u>Blame</u> No One But <u>Myself</u> ... Rom 7:24; James 1:14
 - 2) I Have Fallen Short of God's Standard ... Psalm 51:4; Rom. 3:23
 - 3) I Am Willing to Change... Acts 3:19
 - 2. Mourning Demonstrates Spiritual Maturity
 - ⇒ Spiritual maturity involves growing our ability & desire to conform to God's rule in our lives.
 - ⇒ Two ways we can mature...
 - 1) God's Word Becomes My <u>Guidebook</u> Psalm 119:11

 1st ... a statement of <u>fact</u> *I have hidden your word in my heart*2nd ... a statement of <u>purpose</u> *that I might not sin against you*.
 - 2) The Mind of Christ Becomes My Conscience 1 Cor. 2:14-16
 - 3. Mourning Demonstrates <u>Community</u>
 - 3 specific ways we find community
 - 1) With G<u>od</u> Ephesians 4:30; 2 Cor 1:3-4
 - 2) With Fellow Believers
 - ⇒ We grieve together over the <u>souls</u> of men & women who have not yet <u>found</u> their way <u>home</u>.
 - 3) With Eternity Rev 21:3-4
