Scripture: Luke 12

- 1. We tend to let our lifestyle chase our income.
- 2. Greed is:
 - Wanting more than you need.
 - Keeping what you have to yourself.
- 3. Generosity...
 - makes you rich toward God.
 - breaks the power of greed.
 - focuses on other's needs, not your wants.
 - gives and saves first, then lives on the rest.
